Discovering a Via Ferrata

A thrilling, all-day excursion in the company of Mountain Guides, exploring the Vidi via Ferrata. From the Grostè Pass (2,445 m a.s.l.), take the trail signposted 390 heading north-west to climb the eastern side of Cima Pietra Grande, crossing craggy rocks with stairs and metal wires. Close to the Sperone degli Orti, the trail merges with another one — Sentiero Costanzi. Here it turns to the west, descending towards the Orti della Regina, one of the most picturesque terraces in all of the Brenta Group. Its name, meaning "the Queen's gardens", comes from an ancient legend that claims a queen and her retinue took refuge here, planting flowers and chives. The site is famous not only because of this legend but also because it holds several immense rocks with stunning fossils. From here, hikers descend to Rifugio Graffer and back to the Grostè Pass. Ascent and return using the Grostè lift.

Participants must bring their packed lunch. Not accessible to strollers. Hiking shoes and rain jacket required. The harness and via ferrata kit will be provided by the mountain guides. This route is not recommended for those who suffer from vertigo.

Guided by the experts of the Natural Park, we will set out to discover certain unique geological features of the protected area.

We will make our way through sites that reveal long-hidden secrets, marveling at the rocky expanse known as the Grosté, spread out before the mountain peaks. We will take alternative trails through the magnificent meadows of Camp Centener, leading us past Malga Fevri and into the town of Campiglio. The route is predominantly downhill, starting from an altitude of 2,400 m.a.s.l. at Rifugio Stoppani and arriving at 1,500 m.a.s.l. in Madonna di Campiglio. Participants must bring their packed lunch. For those who do not wish to descend into Campiglio on foot, it is possible to take the Spinale lift independently of the group.

Continuing past them, we will climb to the highest point of a little valley before coming back down and admiring Lake Alto, nestled beneath the Artuich peak. From here, we continue to the beautiful Lake Malghette and into the woods via trail 201, descending back down into the town.

"Discovering the glacier of long ago"

Note: those traveling to the Malga Bedole mountain hut by car are advised to book a space at the Bedole car park using the Azienda di Promozione e del Parco (Park Promotion Agency) website. For those who wish to use the shuttle service instead, booking ahead is essential for the Val Genova Express in Madonna di Campiglio.

A fascinating excursion in the upper part of Val Genova, winding its way between the area's most geologically and geomorphologically significant sites, guided by an expert from the Adamello Brenta Nature Park Geopark.

The itinerary begins at Malga Bedole to reach the nearby Rifugio, the Cambiali bridge, the Pionieri bivouac and, finally, the glacial amphitheater of Matarot. From here, it is possible to admire the waterfalls that tumble down from the Adamello glaciers, during this time of drastic climate change, and to recognize the marks left on the land by its icy past.

From Madonna di Campiglio and Mavignola, there is a shuttle service called the Val di Genova Express, which must be booked ahead of time at www.pnab.it

Clues scattered along this picturesque loop route, which leads to the Cascata d'Amola falls, will reveal to you the secrets of these magical places. There will be a fun reward for anyone who solves all its mysteries!

Around the mountains

An excursion of moderate difficulty and immense natural interest around Val Brenta, the San Giuliano Lakes and XXII Apostoli.

- 1. Val Brenta Rifugio Brentei: from Prà de la Casa (1,155 m a.s.l.) to Malga Brenta Bassa. From here there is a climb to Malga Brenta Alta, a spectacular amphitheater before the Brenta Dolomites. Continue along trail no. 323 and then towards the Rifugio Brentei (2,182 m a.s.l.). The way back to the car park follows the Cascate Alte trail, allowing walkers to admire the spectacular view of the waterfalls with their picturesque little wooden bridges.
- 2. The San Giuliano Lakes: from the village of Caderzone Terme, take the mountain road to the Pozza delle Vacche car park (1,485 metres). From here, turn onto the trail and go through some dense shrubbery past Malga San Giuliano mountain hut to reach a magical glacial basin, where the two lakes lie nestled one next to the other. The area is covered in meadows, alternating with scree patches of glacial moraine. Perched at 1,940 meters between the peaks of Corno Alto, La Cingla and La Costaccia, the blue lakes of S. Giuliano and Garzonè are surrounded by a vast pine wood offering a panoramic view over Val di Genova. Return via the same route.
- 3. Rifugio XII Apostoli: from Pinzolo, take the lift for Pra Rodont and Doss del Sabion 2,100 m. From here, take the trail that leads to the area around the Bregn de L'Ors Pass (1,845 m a.s.l.), then trail no. 307, which rises and falls towards the level green area around Lake Asciutto. At the end of this almost-level stretch, the trail begins to climb sharply towards a gap that provides a way through the rocky barrier. This is the famous Scala Santa, a stretch of the trail equipped with strong steel cables that help climbers make their way up these rocky crags. After this, a long diagonal path leads across a moraine deposit, and a series of rises and rocky terraces brings us to the Rifugio XXII Apostoli (2,489 m a.s.l.), offering majestic panoramic views. The way back retraces the road up, and the lifts are used once again to descend from Doss del Sabion.
- 4. Rifugio Mandrone: from the town of Carisolo, you can drive across Val di Genova to the Malga Bedole car park. Here, it is easy to find the beginning of trail 212, which leads directly to your destination. The trail immediately starts to climb along the side of the mountain and, with a pleasant stretch through the woods, rises steeply to cover an altitude change of around 600 meters, leading to the Rifugio Mandrone (2,449 m a.s.l.). Gradually leaving the vegetation behind, the trail levels out and the terrain starts to take on the distinctive characteristics of the Adamello zone. The route passes by the Julius Payer Glacier Centre, with its permanent exhibition on glaciers and the mountain environment. A final steep stretch that passes close to a little church eventually leads to the lodge, which is situated in front of the Adamello glacier, the largest in the Italian Alps. Return via the same route.
