

ALTO SARCA FISHING ASSOCIATION REGULATIONS 2026

ART. 01

When fishing, anglers must behave appropriately towards fish, the environment, other anglers and those carrying out surveillance. Failure to behave appropriately, repeat offences and the accumulation of penalties may result in the application of penalties, up to and including the suspension of membership, while guests may be reported as undesirable.

ZONES WHERE FISH ARE INTRODUCED:

- P0 SARCA RIVER TIONE – LIMARÒ** – Ponte Arche locality from the bridge to Stenico upstream for 150 m and downstream from the confluence with the Duina stream for 200 m.
- P1 SARCA RIVER TIONE – LIMARÒ** – from Ragoli bridge downstream for 600 m towards Ponte Pià basin.
- P2 DUINA TORRENT** – Ponte Arche area, from the confluence with the Sarca river upstream for 400 m.
- DUINA TORRENT** – Cavrasto area, from Cavrasto bridge downstream for 100 m.
- P3 ARNÒ TORRENT** – Val di Breguzzo, from Maltina bridge upstream for 400 m.
- P4 SARCA RIVER TIONE – PINZOLO** – area of Villa Rendena bridge, from the beginning of the former Valentini fish farm to Villa Rendena bridge.
- SARCA RIVER TIONE – PINZOLO** – Strembo area from the upstream filter weir to the start of the upper lake for 650 m.
- P5 SARCA RIVER OF VAL GENOVA** – Carisolo area, from 200 m downstream to 200 m upstream of Vecchia Vetreria bridge.
- P6 SARCA RIVER OF CAMPIGLIO** –Tulot area, starting from 100 m downstream of confluence with Sarca di Nambrone, downstream for 400 m.

ZONES Z: same regulations as the section in which they are located

NK (NO-KILL) ZONES
(see regulations art. 17)

PERMITTED IN ALL WATERS LICENSED TO THE ASSOCIATION, INCLUDING THE RESERVES. SPECIAL PERMIT IS REQUIRED FOR RESERVES.

NK0 Sarca river Ponte Arche (460 m upstream from the confluence of the Rio Tanfurin with the Sarca river and downstream for 350 m from Rio Tanfurin). **Fishing with barbless single hook spinners (spinners spoons, minnows) are permitted in this zone.**

NK1 Sarca river Preore-Sesena area from Preore water intake structure downstream to the confluence with Rio Maftina.

NK2 Sarca di Spiazzo from the ford at Cunaccia dump to the cycle track bridge in front of Acqua Life (Parco Naturale Adamello Brenta).

NK3 Sarca di Giustino from the weir upstream the confluence with Giustino purification plant discharge downstream to the confluence with Flanginec torrent (Maffei canal).

NK4 Sarca di Val Genova from Nardis waterfalls bridge downstream to Ponte Verde.

NK6 Sarca Madonna di Campiglio from Amazzonia bridge to 150 m upstream of Casa degli Alpini. **Fishing with barbless single hook spinners (spinners spoons, minnows) are permitted in this zone.**

RESERVES:
(see regulations art. 21)

MEMBERS AND GUESTS MUST RESERVE AND BUY A SPECIFIC PERMIT AT THE HEADQUARTERS OR AUTHORISED VENDORS.

R1. REGORIE RESERVE– From Ragoli bridge upstream for 1.350 m to Bolza trout farm water intake structure. Access only by reservation and with specific permit. Please note that occasionally the water of this reserve may be turbid and not fishable due to occasional works on the river bed.

R2. ARNÒ RESERVE – From the cement ford to 250 m downstream the “Pont de la Cazza” bridge. Length 1.100 m. Access only by reservation and with specific permit.

R3. RIO VALLESINELLA RESERVE – From Rio Vallesinella and Sarca of Campiglio confluence to 250 m upstream the Brenta Bassa bridge. Length 700 m. Access only by reservation and with specific permit.

R4. MAROC DEL GHIRO RESERVE – From the Battocchi junction to 200 m after the Masere Bridge, for a total length of 700 m. Access only by reservation and with specific permit.

R5. NAMBINO LAKE RESERVE – on Lake Nambino. Access only by reservation and with specific permit. (See regulations of Associazione Pescatori Madonna di Campiglio).

LN. LAKE NEMBIA RESERVE (see regulations art. 22)

ART. 03

RESTRICTIONS:

1. FISHING IS PROHIBITED ON **NON-HOLIDAY FRIDAYS** IN ALL P ZONES (0/1/2/3/4/5/6).
2. FISHING IS PROHIBITED ON **NON-HOLIDAY FRIDAYS** IN PONTE PIÀ BASIN (S).
3. FISHING IS PROHIBITED IN ALPINE LAKES AND TRIBUTARIES (D, G2, H1, L, M, N, O, P, R, X, W, Z) EVERYDAY **EXCEPT WEDNESDAY, SATURDAY, SUNDAY AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.**
4. FORBIDDEN TO **RETAIN MARBLE TROUT** IN ALL WATERS.
5. FORBIDDEN TO **RETAIN GRAYLING** IN ALL WATERS.
6. FORBIDDEN TO **RETAIN SCULPIN** IN ALL WATERS.
7. FORBIDDEN TO **RETAIN SHRIMP** IN ALL WATERS.

FISHING BANS: see black zones on the map

ART. 04

FISHING IS PROHIBITED BY THE FOLLOWING MEANS AND METHODS:

with hooks or hooks equipped with barbs, boats, the use of maggots, baiting, nets, spears, with your hands, landing nets, explosives, poisonous substances, electric current, barriers, as well as fish as live bait unless they are caught on site and used immediately.

The use of landing nets is permitted and is mandatory in all Reserves, in NO-KILL areas, and Lake Nembia solely for landing fish that have already been hooked.

Spears fishing is prohibited.

The collection of macroinvertebrates for use as bait is prohibited between 1 January and 30 April each year.

In lakes, the use of a "bottle" is permitted for catching up to a maximum of 50 minnows per day to be used as bait.

- Natural bait is prohibited in NO-KILL areas.
- For the Ponte Pià basin, see specific regulation art. 18.

ART. 05

IN ALL WATERS A MAXIMUM OF ONE SALMONID, EXCEPT IN NO KILL ZONES AND RESERVES, OF AT LEAST 55 CM, MAY BE KEPT PER DAY (SEE EXAMPLES ON FISHING RECORD BOOKLET). MARBLE TROUT AND GRAYLING PROHIBITED.

The length of the fish is measured from the tip of the head to the end of the tail fin. Anglers must have a suitable instrument for measuring any fish that are kept.

ART. 06

LIMITATIONS:

In all cases, a maximum of five salmonids may be caught per person per day.

- 1. The number of fish caught must be recorded. Also if you stop fishing.**
2. From October 1st to November 30th, in the Ponte Pià basin only, it is permitted to fish for rainbow trout and white fish, provided the specific regulations are followed.
- 3. In all waters, once the maximum number of five (5) salmonids has been reached, the angler must stop fishing completely, even for other species.**

ART. 07

Fish caught during the closed season, below the minimum size limit or intended to be released, must be freed without removing them from the water, taking the utmost care and wetting your hands before touching them. When it is not possible to free the hook without harming the fish, the line must be cut.

Fish must not be mistreated under any circumstances.

Fish that are kept must be stored in a suitable personal container and may not be combined with those of other anglers (except as provided for in point 2 of Art. 08). **It is forbidden to leave fish on the banks or dead fish in the water.**

ART. 08

It is forbidden to catch fish for other fishermen, or to purchase, sell, transfer or exchange fish catches.

Guest anglers up to the age of 14:

may fish accompanied by an angler without a permit, provided that their companion or guest has one. The catch will be added to the total for both anglers (maximum 5 salmonids); alternatively, they may obtain a regular permit and keep a maximum of 5 salmonids. The two may fish with their own rods.

For the Reserves and Lake Nembia, minors up to the age of 14 may fish without a permit provided that their companion has one. The two must take turns fishing as the permit is valid for only one rod, or the minor may also obtain a regular permit. Each fisherman may accompany only one minor.

ART. 09

Fishing is permitted from one hour before sunrise until one hour after sunset (astronomical time). Unless otherwise indicated.

ART. 10

In running waters, in Cornisello lakes and in the Strembo basin only one rod may be used, with no more than TWO hooks or TWO triple-grip hooks or TWO artificial baits.

In the Ponte Pià basin and in the lakes, except for Cornisello lakes, the following equipment may be used:

A. One rod with a maximum of three hooks or three triple-grip hooks or three artificial baits. A maximum of three hooks is permitted when a series of flies or larvae is used.

B. Two rods with a total of no more than five hooks. A maximum of three hooks or three triple-grip hooks or three artificial baits may be used on each rod.

The use of fish as live bait is permitted in all waters (with the exception of NO-KILL zones and reserves) only if caught locally and used immediately.

ART. 11

It is forbidden to bring non-permitted gear and bait onto the fishing site.

From the opening to 31st March, fishing is permitted from the shore with dry feet. It is allowed to cross the river at weirs or scrapes. Only in the reserves (R1, R2, R4, LN) is permitted to enter in the water from the opening.

It is forbidden to damage, tamper with or remove the signs or markings placed there by the Water Concessionary Association.

A claim for damages against the offender is provided for.

ART. 12

Fishing under the license of the Upper Sarca Fishing Association requires a permit or booklet for recording catches. The holder is responsible for the validity of this permit.

These documents are strictly personal and are to be shown to wardens upon request.

Before beginning to fish, **the angler must write in the record booklet or day permit in indelible ink** the date and the fishing zone, as explained by the instructions given in the booklet or permit. **After each catch, the number of fish caught and kept, as well as their measurements, must be noted, even if the angler then stops fishing.**

ART. 13

In order to allow the necessary controls, upon the request of the wardens, anglers must show the fish they have caught and open their portable containers and vehicles. Upon the request of the wardens, anglers must immediately reel in their line and show the bait and methods used. The fisherman with a boat or bellyboat is forced, following a manifest call from the staff supervising person, to approach the shore for the appropriate checks.

ART. 14

In the cases provided for in Art. 22.3 of Provincial Law No. 60/78 and subsequent amendments and additions, fish caught illegally will be confiscated, the guest permit suspended, and the membership card withdrawn in accordance with Art. 1 and Art. 24.

ART. 15

Fishing competitions may not be held in concession waters without the concessionaire's authorisation. For competition fields, see specific regulations, Art. 26 of these regulations.

ART. 16

For anything not covered by the present regulations, the fishing laws currently in force shall apply.

ART. 17

SPECIFIC REGULATIONS FOR NO-KILL FISHING

No-kill fishing is permitted in all waters licensed to the Association and in the no-kill zones described in art. 2, subject to the following restrictions. (for NK0 and NK6 see point 13):

Before beginning no-kill fishing, anglers must write NK for the zone on the fishing permit or booklet and cross out the boxes indicating catches.

It is forbidden to take fish into these zones.

1. Fish that are caught may not be kept, and they must be released in such a way as to avoid harming them.
2. The fishing zones are indicated by signposts along the river.
3. No-kill fishing is permitted in all waters licensed to the Association and in no kill zones. **(It is permitted in the reserves and Lake Nembia only with specific permit. See art. 21 art. 22)**
4. Anyone who engages in no-kill fishing **may not engage in any other type of fishing on the same day in any of the waters licensed to the Association, and vice versa.**
5. Is permitted using all dry-fly, nymph and streamer techniques, with no more than two barbless single hooks.
6. The fishing techniques permitted are mice tails, valesiana, and fly fishing float fishing (with maximum two artificial flies).
7. After 31st March anglers may stand in the water.
8. See internal regulations for penalties.
9. The river may be crossed at weirs or riffles.
10. No fish may be kept at any point during the day.
11. For anything not covered by the present regulations, current fishing laws and internal regulations apply.
12. **In no kill zones and reserves penalties are doubled.**
13. **IN ZONES NK0 AND NK6 FISHING WITH BARBLESS SINGLE HOOK SPINNERS OR MINNOWS ARE PERMITTED.**
14. **FISH THAT ARE CAUGHT MUST BE FREED AS CAREFULLY AS POSSIBLE, WITHOUT REMOVING THEM FROM THE WATER, AND HANDS MUST BE WET BEFORE TOUCHING THEM.**
15. **USE OF A LANDING NET IS COMPULSORY (PREFERABLY RUBBERISED)**

ART. 18

PONTE PIÀ BASIN REGULATIONS

FISHING WITH BARBED HOOKS IS PERMITTED IN THE PONTE PIÀ BASIN ONLY. FISHING WITH MAGGOTS IS PERMITTED. MAX. 50G PER ANGLER PER DAY.

THE PONTE PIÀ BASIN IS OPEN FROM 14/03/2026 (provided most of the ice has melted) TO 30/11/2026. CLOSED ON NON-HOLIDAY FRIDAYS.

Scales may be used IN THE PONTE PIÀ BASIN ONLY, with a maximum length of 1.50m and with a minimum mesh size of 10mm, for roach, rudd, bleak, minnows, loach and chub, to be used as live bait.

Groundbaiting is permitted, using plant substances only. Max 1,5 kg per person per day, 0,5 kg in July and August.

From 1/10 to 30/11, only in Ponte Pià basin, only white fish may be caught, and no more than 70 rainbow trout in total throughout the period. The regulation that applies to all waters licensed to the Association is also applicable here. **Any other salmonids caught** must be immediately freed without removing them from the water, and the line should be cut if necessary.

ART. 19

REGULATIONS FOR CARP AND TENCH NIGHT FISHING IN PONTE PIÀ BASIN (NO-KILL)

1. Night fishing is permitted in the Ponte Pià basin from 01/07/2026 to 30/09/2026.
2. Fishing is permitted from 18:00 to 8:00 of the following day, and the session must be written in the relevant boxes in the record booklet or on the day permit.
3. All fish caught must be returned to the water.
4. Fish must be released in such a way as to avoid harming them.
5. No other fish must be brought onto the fishing site.
6. Barbed hooks are permitted.
7. Groundbaiting is permitted, using plant substances only. Max 1,5 kg per person per day in July and August max 500g per person per day.
8. Night fishing is forbidden on Fridays, except for public holidays.
9. For anything not covered by the present regulations, current fishing laws and internal regulations apply.

OPENING:

R1 – REGORIE FROM 21/02/2026 TO 31/10/2026

R2 – ARNÒ FROM 21/02/2026 TO 30/09/2026

R3 – RIO VALLESINELLA FROM 18/04/2026 TO 30/09/2026

R4 – MAROC DEL GHIRO FROM 21/02/2026 TO 31/10/2026

R5 – NAMBINO FROM FROM COMPLETE THAW* TO 15/10/2026

OBLIGATION TO:

BOOK AND PURCHASE the appropriate permit for guests and members at the headquarters or authorised retailers. (See list).

PRACTISE NO-KILL FISHING (no catch).

**Only for the Nambino R5 reserve, in July and August 2026 it will be possible to keep up to 3 salmonids - Char Project

USE A LANDING NET (PREFERABLY RUBBERISED)

REGULATIONS:

1. The fishing zones are indicated by signposts along the river (R1 – R2 – R3 – R4 – R5).
2. Fishing in these zones is permitted from 7:00am to sunset (astronomical time).
3. It is permitted to fish in more than one zone of Alto Sarca on the same day (other reserves excluded) engaging only in no-kill fishing. For no-kill zones see art. 17.
4. **In Reserves R1, R2, R3 and R4, fishing is permitted using all dry-fly, nymph and streamer techniques, with no more than two barbless hooks.**
5. **In Reserve R5 fishing is permitted using all dry-fly, nymph and streamer techniques, with no more than two barbless hooks and with single-hook spinners.**
6. Anglers can enter the water.
7. For anything not covered by the present regulations, current fishing laws and internal regulations apply.
8. No other fish must be brought into these zones.
9. In Reserves penalties are doubled.
10. **FISH THAT ARE CAUGHT MUST BE FREED AS CAREFULLY AS POSSIBLE, WITHOUT REMOVING THEM FROM THE WATER, AND HANDS MUST BE WET BEFORE TOUCHING THEM.**
11. **LANDING NET (PREFERABLY RUBBER FISHING NET) MUST BE USED IN EVERY RESERVES.**

ART. 22

REGULATIONS FOR LAKE NEMBIA (LN)

OBLIGATION TO:

BOOK AND PURCHASE the appropriate permit for guests and members at the headquarters or authorised retailers. (See list).

PRACTISE NO-KILL FISHING (no catch).

REGULATIONS:

1. **Only one rod may be used, with a maximum of two barbless hooks or spinners with single hook.**
2. Any fish that are returned to the water must be released in such a way as to avoid harming them and without removing them from the water
3. The reserve is indicated by a signpost marked with “LAGO NEMBIA”.
4. Fishing is permitted in the reserve from 7:00am to sunset (astronomical time).
5. In the event that the angler wishes to fish in Nembia lake and then in another zone, it is possible, but not in Reserves and always no kill fishing.
6. **The following fishing techniques are permitted: fly, nymph, streamer, camolera, spinners minnow and undulating.**
7. **Fishing with live bait (larvae, worms, bleak, etc.), soft bait or trout bait is prohibited.**
8. Anglers can enter the water.
9. For anything not covered by the present regulations, current fishing laws and internal regulations apply.
10. Fishing with boats is prohibited, except for belly boats.
11. **FISH THAT ARE CAUGHT MUST BE FREED AS CAREFULLY AS POSSIBLE, WITHOUT REMOVING THEM FROM THE WATER, AND HANDS MUST BE WET BEFORE TOUCHING THEM. FAILED COMPLIANCE WITH THIS RULE MAY IMPLY THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE DAILY PERMIT.**

12. LANDING NET (PREFERABLY RUBBER FISHING NET) MUST BE USED IN LAKE NEMBIA.

13. IN SUMMER TIME, BEACH AND SWIM AREAS, MUST BE RESPECTED.

ART. 23

Permits purchased in virtual/digital form, whether daily, multi-day or seasonal, must always be available for inspection by enforcement officers.

If this is not possible, for example due to a flat mobile phone battery or loss of the phone, the fisherman must stop fishing, as he will be considered to be without a permit and therefore penalised in accordance with Art. 24, paragraph p., unless the security personnel can verify that the permit has been purchased.

Please note that the supervisory staff are equipped with a special application for checking purchased permits (data, date and time) even when there is no connection.

Please note that permits are non-refundable, so when purchasing, it is advisable to always check the date and location selected before proceeding with payment.

ART. 24

PENALTIES AND DISCIPLINARY MEASURES:

Without prejudice to the provisions of Provincial Law No. 60/78 and subsequent amendments and additions concerning criminal and administrative penalties and National Laws, in all cases of proven penalties, the fishing permit will be immediately withdrawn by the supervisory staff and deposited at the registered office.

The fisherman (member or guest) will not be able to use daily permits for the entire duration of the penalty established by the Association.

At the end of the penalty period, the member or guest will be able to collect their permit, while the guest will be able to use daily fishing permits again.

No conciliatory settlement is permitted with regard to the Association. In accordance with the provisions of Article 19 of the implementing regulation of Provincial Law No. 60/78 and subsequent amendments and additions, failure to comply with these internal regulations is also punishable under Article 22 of Provincial Law No. 60/78 by the Provincial Administration. The Association reserves the right, however, to claim damages from the offender.

IN NO-KILL AREAS, RESERVES AND LAKE NEMBIA, THE ABOVE PENALTIES WILL BE DOUBLED.

ART. 25

REGULATIONS FOR USING THE STATIONS FOR THE DISABLED

1. People with physical disabilities have absolute precedence in the use of the stations distributed throughout the territory.
2. The stations are designed to hold at maximum 2 anglers at the same time.
3. The presence on the station of anglers with physical disabilities implies the obligation on the part of those fishing in the vicinity to keep a minimum distance from the station of 10m on each side.
4. Non-compliance with the regulations will be sanctioned according to the provisions of art. 24, letter "t" of the internal regulations.

**REGULATION FOR FISHING IN OCTOBER
CATCH & RELEASE MODE
Pursuant to resolution no. 1176 of 07 August 2020**

Fishing is permitted in October with the following restrictions and requirements:

1. All must be in possession of a regular fishing permit issued by the Association.
2. Use exclusively of lures armed with a single barbless hook.
3. It is absolutely forbidden to keep the fish caught and the same must be released so as not to cause damage (catch & release mode).
4. Fishing is allowed: Fly with maximum 2 flies or 2 nymphs or 1 streamer with: rat tail - tenkara - Valsesian.
5. Fishing is allowed: spinning armed with 1 lure: rotating - minnows - waving - spinfly.
6. Ban on the use of silicone lures, gums, batters and natural baits.
7. Ban on the use of lures longer than 6cm.
8. Obligation to use the landing net. (preferably rubberised).

For the 3 Reserves present in the October fishing area (R1 - Regorie, R4 - Maroc del Ghiro, R5 – Nambino Lake), the obligation to book and purchase the appropriate permit for guests and members remains, respecting the specific Regulations (art. 21 of the 2025 Regulation). The R5 Reserve – Lake Nambino closes on 15/10/2026.

FISHING AREAS IN OCTOBER:

- Fly fishing only as per point 4:
From the start of Nk4 in Val Genova to the end of R1 Regorie.
- Fly fishing and spinning as per points 4 and 5:
From the end of R1 Regorie up to the beginning of the Ponte Pià basin and fishing prohibition downstream of the Ponte Pià basin up to 70 m downstream of the old bridge of Terme on the Sarca river in Ponte Arche.

For anything not mentioned, reference is made to the 2025 Regulation.

NB: Penalties and disciplinary sanctions for fishing in October are doubled. At the end of the day, it is mandatory to record the total catches released by recording: Date - Area - Species - Measure The member / guest booklets must be returned to the headquarters of the Alto Sarca Fishermen's Association in Tione di Trento.

FISHING SAFELY:

Please note that modern carbon fibre rods, although lightweight and efficient, are extremely dangerous if they come into contact with power lines: it is therefore essential to always check your surroundings and look up before starting to fish.

When fishing in streams, it is easy to slip. We recommend wearing suitable footwear and moving carefully, using a stick if necessary, to avoid falls, injuries and damage to equipment.

Particular attention should be paid to sudden floods, especially downstream of hydroelectric intakes, and the signs in place should always be respected.

In isolated areas, your phone may not work: it is therefore advisable to inform someone of your destination and to carry a whistle, a pocket torch and a light waterproof jacket, which may be useful in case of emergency or bad weather.
